

ORDINANCE 20-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RE-ENACTING THE PROVISIONS OF CERTAIN SECTIONS OF TITLE 3 OF THE CITY ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF HEBRON, MORTON COUNTY, NORTH DAKOTA, OF 1971, AND ALL SUBSEQUENT REVISIONS THERETO, SAID REVISED ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE MUNICIPAL JUDGE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HEBRON, MORTON COUNTY, NORTH DAKOTA, AS FOLLOWS:

That Section 3-0216 of Title 3 of the Hebron City Ordinances and all subsequent amendments thereto, of the City of Hebron, Morton County, North Dakota, is hereby amended and re-enacted as follows:

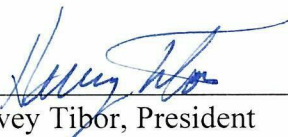
3-0216. Municipal Judge

There shall be elected each four years a Municipal Judge who shall hold office until a successor is elected and qualified. Such Municipal Judge is required to be licensed to practice law in this state. The Municipal Judge shall perform all the duties prescribed by law and the ordinances of this City. All fines, penalties, and forfeitures for the violation of any City Ordinance shall when collected, be paid to the City Auditor.

That Section 3-0222 of Title 3 of the Hebron City Ordinances and all subsequent amendments thereto, of the City of Hebron, Morton County, North Dakota, is hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

EFFECTIVE DATE. The Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its final passage and approval and publication of its title and penalty clause.
