

ORDINANCE NO. 21-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RE-ENACTING TITLE 16 "ORDINANCES AND PENALTIES", SECTION 16-107 "GENERAL PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION" AND REPEALING SECTIONS 16-108, 16-109, 16-110, 16-111, 16-112, 16-113 AND 16-114 OF THE HEBRON CITY ORDINANCES OF 1971.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HEBRON, MORTON COUNTY, NORTH DAKOTA, AS FOLLOWS:

Title 16, Section 16-107 "General Penalties" shall be amended and re-enacted as follows:

16-107 General Penalties

Any person who is convicted of an offense under this ordinance may be punished by a fine of not more than One-Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), thirty (30) days imprisonment, or both such fine and imprisonment.

Any person who is convicted of an infraction under this ordinance may be punished by a fine of not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).

This section does not prohibit the use of the sentencing alternatives, other than a fine or imprisonment, for the violation of a city ordinance, nor does this section limit the use of deferred or suspended sentences.

This provision also acts to amend and re-enact all penalty provisions of any individual sections of the Hebron City ordinances and all previous amendments thereto as well as any and all other offense or infraction penalties provided in any other Hebron criminal, nuisance, traffic, or other city ordinance which refers to an "offense" or "infraction."

The title and penalty section of the above Ordinance is published in accordance with the Laws of the State of North Dakota.
